This year's Luau will be held on April 13th from 3-4pm. The price is \$3 if paid by April 11th and \$4 after the 11th.

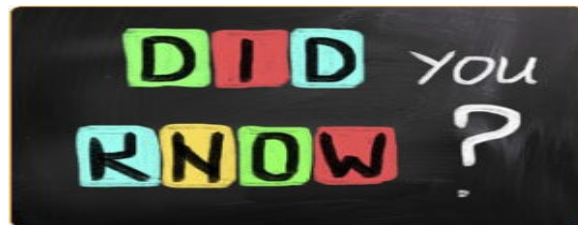
Concessions will be provided by Hoosier Mama's Tasty Treats. Students will not be admitted without a permission slip. Please be on the look out for the form in your child's folder.
